Bennachie video selling well

"BENNACHIE", the newly completed video from the Grimley Partnership, commissioned by the Bailies of Bennachie, is selling like hot cakes.

In the three weeks since its release well over 100 copies have been snapped up, to the delight of members of the Bailies Council who are hoping to capture the Christmas market.

The 35-minute film captures the ethos of the hill in a spell-binding way, and should be a winner with lovers of Bennachie at home and abroad.

Scenes include the 1990 rally and close-ups of those who attended, Dr. Danny Gordon, founder of the Bailies speaking on their aims, the various routes to the summit, some of the legends associated with the hill, some of its landmarks, its trees and plants.

The breathtaking scenery is portrayed to the accompaniment of Bennachie verse, fiddle music and songs by local artists.
