RENAMING OF BENNACHIE CAR PARK

I have just had Mr Bruce of the Technical Services on the telephone and he and the Councillor are in agreement that the name should be changed to Pittodrie car park as per my previous letter to you.

The only comment the Councillor made was that Mr Theo Smith should be approached and informed, and if possible we should get his agreement to the renaming. He too is obviously anxious that the public should not mistake the signpost for the way to the hotel, and Mr Smith is also concerned that this will happen, we may be forced to insert the words "not Pittodrie Hotel" under the car park sign. I would hope that this would not be necessary. The public is not accustomed to seeing blue and white signs in the normal roadside livery advertising hotels and I do not think there should be any confusion here.

Rather than approach Theo Smith myself (whom I have never met) I think it would be better if whichever of the Bailies gets on best with him should approach him and try and talk him into agreement. It would be a great pity if the renaming were to stumble at this point.



If relations are not too good with the Bailies and Theo Smith, however, please let me know and I will arrange to visit Theo Smith myself. I leave it to you to assess whichever method has the best chance of success.
