

# No call-in for Oyne bid

**A PROPOSAL** to build a garden centre at Ryehill, Oyne, will not be called in by Grampian Regional Council it was decided last week.

Regional planners recommended that the application for planning permission should be called in but councillors overturned the recommendation.

The committee were told that Gordon District Council had indicated they were prepared to approve the application which is

considered contrary to their Local Plan.

Councillor George Swapp said the application which includes a drawing office, garden centre, storage yard and house, had widespread support locally and was considered to be an ideal site.

Councillor Rhona Kemp pointed out support had come from the Baillies of Bennachie and committee agreed to leave the proposal with the district council for their determination.
